Item 10 Pkg 301-2 A piece of stucco covered Styrofoam from the east exterior wall.

Item 11 Pkg 301-12 A bullet fragment found in the Village Inn east parking lot closer to the building.

Item 12 Pkg 301-13 A bullet fragment found in the Village Inn east parking lot.

Item 13 Pkg 327- A biohazard bag booked in for destruction.







Case Follow-up

After reviewing the evidence in this case, it could not be determined by Officer Webb whether he had compared the known prints from E.C. Wright to the unknown prints found on the vehicles from the scene. On 10/10/08, I went into the evidence room and looked at the prints recovered from the vehicles to ensure they were comparable. I resealed the items and signed the seals. I sent the following items to the Bureau of Forensic Services to be compared to the known prints of the suspect in this case: Item 1 Pkg 301-1b, Item 21 Pkg 301-21b, Item 22 Pkg 301-22b, Item 5 Pkg 361-7, Item 6 Pkg 361-8, and Item 20 Pkg 314-16. **Carlson's Infiniti: 361-7 = palmprint; 361-8 = fingerprint**

Items 1, 21, and 22 were recovered from the victim's Navigator. Items 5 and 6 were recovered from the witness' Infiniti. Item 20 is the full set of known prints from E. Christopher Wright.

I also left a message with Karen Elliott, Forensic Manager, to inform her of the situation and the time constraints of the next trial date. The items will be transported on S. Tormey's normal day.
